

## CANONIZATION

What does it take to become a saint? A cause for canonization begins in a diocese. Usually the diocese in which the person lived or died. In many cases a group will petition the local bishop to open an investigation into the virtues of the person. Once the bishop agrees to open the investigation and begin the process, the person becomes known as "Servant of God."

This process normally begins five years or more after the person's death. The Pope has the authority to waive this rule, as was the case with Mother Theresa and Pope John Paul II.

A guild is formed, tasked with doing a thorough investigation of the candidate's life, their writings, speeches and sermons. A detailed biography is written, and if there are living individuals who knew the person, they are interviewed.

From there the bishop presents the information gathered about the Servant of God to a Vatican office called the Congregation for the Causes of the Saints. The congregation then assigns a postulator to the cause, whose job is to continue gathering more information about the Servant of God.

The steps to sainthood in the Catholic Church are Servant of God, Venerable, Blessed, and Saint.

## TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The fact that many monastic churches do not have a prominent tabernacle shapes the patterns of liturgical prayer. Monastic communities often protect the ancient value of "receiving from the same sacrifice," meaning that the communicants are assured that what they eat and drink in the Holy Mysteries actually comes from the same celebration. It surprises many to learn that the Church does not foresee, nor does it provide for, Communion of the faithful from the reserved Sacrament. Liturgical laws have long defended your right to receive from the same sacrifice, the same Mass, that you attend.

At one time, of course, the bread for the Eucharist was the ordinary bread of the day, except unleavened, probably prepared at home. It was broken and distributed to the faithful. Early on the loaf itself was referred to as the *hostia* in Latin, meaning the "sacrifice," the same word for the sacrificial animal in Jewish worship, and for Jesus as the Lamb of God. By giving his life on the cross, Jesus became the *hostia* for us. To this day in the Greek Church, one of the tasks of the priest's wife is to bake the bread for the Divine Liturgy, sometimes in a bakery oven dedicated to that purpose and called a "Bethlehem."

Today's familiar individual hosts first appeared in the eleventh century at about the time when tabernacles were coming into use. The turn away from "bread" bread allowed the hosts to be reserved since they did not spoil like regular bread, and made the annual "Easter duty" counts easier.

## CANONIZATION

¿Qué se necesita para convertirse en un santo? "Una causa para la canonización comienza en una diócesis. Por lo general, la diócesis en que la persona vivió o murió. En muchos casos, un grupo pedirá al obispo local que abra una investigación sobre las virtudes de la persona.

Una vez que el obispo acepta abrir la investigación e iniciar el proceso, la persona se conoce como "Siervo de Dios". Este proceso normalmente comienza cinco años o más después de la muerte de la persona. El Papa tiene la autoridad para renunciar a esta regla, como fue el caso de Madre Teresa y el Papa Juan Pablo II. Un gremio es el formado, encargado de hacer una investigación exhaustiva de la vida del candidato, sus escritos, discursos y sermones.

Se escribe una biografía detallada, y si hay individuos vivos que conocieron a la persona, se les entrevista. Desde allí el obispo presenta la información recogida sobre el Siervo de Dios a una oficina del Vaticano llamada Congregación para las Causas de los Santos.

La congregación entonces asigna un postulador a la causa, cuyo trabajo es continuar reuniendo más información sobre el Siervo de Dios. Los pasos para la santidad en la Iglesia Católica son Siervo de Dios, Venerable, Bendito y Santo.
