

**Fee Schedule for Funerals and Memorials  
at Holy Name Catholic Church in Chickasha**

\*Organist/Pianist Fee      \$125  
Made payable directly to the musician *prior* to the Funeral/Memorial Mass  
This may be the day of the mass, but should be before the mass begins

This will most likely be the Director of Music and Organist:  
**Alvez Barkoskie IV**

In the event that Mr. Barkoskie is unavailable he will secure another Organist or  
Pianist to play for the funeral

\*Cantor      \$75  
Made payable directly to the musician *prior* to the Funeral/Memorial Mass  
This may be the day of the mass, but should be before the mass begins

\* It is the preference at Holy Name Parish that the musicians used for funerals and memorials are associated with the Parish. (i.e. the Director of Music and members of the Holy Name choirs). In the event that the family wishes to use a family member as a singer or instrumentalist during a mass this will have to be approved by the Director of Music of Holy Name. This is simply to ensure that the best quality of music is provided in your time of bereavement and that appropriate music is chosen and played for the Rite of Christian Burial. **In all cases, the music selected for any funeral or memorial mass at Holy Name must be approved by the Director of Music and Organist.**

\*In the event that a Holy Name choir is requested (and available) to sing for a funeral/memorial instead of a cantor, the cantor fee of \$75 should be made out to Holy Name Catholic Church and the fee will go towards the music ministry.
